

Project Rebound Who We Are

- John Irwin
 - Convicted of robbery, served time at CTF
 - Completed a semester of college while incarcerated
 - Post-release, attended UCLA, earning a bachelor's degree
 - Earned a PhD from Cal Berkeley
 - Hired as faculty at SFSU
 - 1967 Project Rebound began at SFSU
- 2016, eight California State University campuses add Project Rebound with assistance of a grant
- 2019, Governor Newsom signs the CA State budget with Project Rebound as a line item
