Family Unification Program (FUP) Vouchers	Youth age 18-24 that have left foster care or will leave within 90 days, and are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless (includes out-of-home probation youth)	Up to 36 months of subsidized housing & up to 18 months of supportive services	Public Housing Authorities that administer FUP: https://tinyurl.com/FUP-vouchers-all-years More info: https://tinyurl.com/FUP-info
Foster Youth to Independence (FYI) Vouchers	Youth age 18-24 that have left foster care or will leave within 90 days, and are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless (includes out-of-home probation youth)	Up to 36 months of subsidized housing & supportive services	Public Housing Authorities eligible to administer FYI: https://tinyurl.com/FYI-eligible-PHAs More info: https://tinyurl.com/FYI-TPV
