

MANAGERS LEADERSHIP ACADEMY ORANGE COUNTY – SPRING 2026 APPLICATION DUE March 2, 2026

CPOCF is pleased to announce the delivery of CPOC's Managers Leadership Academy Orange County, which will be held Week 1: April 27 – May 1, 2026 and Week 2: June 8-12, 2026 in Orange County, California. CPOC's MLA program meets BSCC's Manager Core requirement (MACC equivalency).

The 80-hour intensive training course is designed to prepare current probation managers for executive positions. The course blends practical skill building, individualized leadership development, and a focus on ethical, data-driven decision making to cultivate California's future probation leadership. The course is comprised of two weeks of classroom training, an intersession practicum assignment, self-paced learning modules, peer study groups, and a 360-leadership assessment.

This demanding course is designed for future probation executives - participants must be highly motivated and focused in order to be successful. Given that the course is intended for future executives, work products are expected to be comprehensive, high quality and reflect the complexity of county-level probation management. Once accepted to the course, participants are expected to participate in order to advance their own learning and complete all course requirements.

Prior to the first session, participants are expected to:

- Attend a 2-Hour LPI enrollment Webinar scheduled for <u>Tuesday, March</u> <u>24, 2026 from 9:00am to 11:00am</u>, and to complete the Leadership Practices Inventory (LPI) 360 assessment, developed by Jim Kouzes and Barry Posner.
- Complete 5 hours of self-paced learning on CPOC's on-demand platform (instruction will be provided with enrollment confirmation)
- Participants will be assigned to study groups during Session One in order to complete a team assignment. Teams are expected to meet for two hours each day, Monday-Thursday, during the classroom session, over lunch, and/or in the evenings.
- During the intersession break between Week One and Week Two, participants are expected to:
 - Complete a practicum exercise and prepare a 10-minute report out on key learnings from the assignment.
 - Participate in a 30-minute one-on-one coaching session with an LPI Consultant to go over results of their 360-Leadership assessment via phone or Zoom Meeting.
