- 162 employees with 120 sworn

PROBATION OUTREACH VEHICLES

Facilitate remote visits and transpiration, collaborating with partners to provide mental health and drug treatment services.

MOBILE TEMPORARY SHELTER (MTS)

MTS was a result of a lawsuit

- Probation built it in 6 weeks

Offered warming/cooling shelters
during transition

Meeting clients where they are at

- Location – creeks, homeless encampments, etc.
- Mentally and Physically
