GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

SJ CARES is designed to address homelessness by collaborating with local agencies, law enforcement, and community organizations to consolidate outreach initiatives throughout San Joaquin County. Our team works diligently to identify, assess, and connect individuals experiencing homelessness with the necessary supportive services available within the County.

We are committed to providing comprehensive wrap-around services tailored to meet the unique needs of each individual, resulting in a reduction of individuals experiencing homelessness. The goal of SJCARES is to build relationships, gain trust, and encourage individuals to accept services.



















THE TEAM

Our program has two teams with similar yet different focuses. Our 1.0 team performs outreach and engagement in the community. We receive referrals from our law enforcement partners, community stakeholders, and the community itself. We target our highest utilizers of services and build rapport in an attempt to move them along in our program toward self-sufficiency.

Our 2.0 team focuses strictly on case management. They do help with our 1.0 team members; however, their primary focus are those clients who are actively participating in our program. They conduct weekly visits to help break down barriers to move them through their continuum towards self-sufficiency. They address all gaps and triage the reason a client is unhoused and what has contributed to their situation of homelessness.




































































































- Capture client information in real time
- Geo-enabled to locate shelters, encampments, hospitals, and providers




- Custom algorithms to qualify and allocate individuals/families based on demographics, health, and legal history
- For the first time: Shelter owners directly update PIT counts in real time
- Integration ensures accurate bed availability for better resource utilization










- **Integrated risk** scoring at individual and encampment levels
- **Enables proactive** measures to prevent incidents and keep staff safe

In the last 16 months, SJ CARES has made 4,868 contacts

We have connected with 770 unique individuals and of those, 37% have agreed to work with SJ CARES

We have successfully housed 90 individuals who were previously on the streets

Of those housed, 30% secured permanent housing while 10% were reunited with family


