Concerns Regarding Psychiatric Hospital/Inpatient Services in California

Psychiatric Hospitals are <u>LICENSED</u> by the California Department of Public Health (<u>DPH</u>). And then they are <u>DESIGNATE & APPROVED</u> for the involuntary detainment, evaluation & treatment by **DHCS**.

Facilities are <u>designated and approved for the involuntary detainment</u>, evaluation and treatment of children pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code (WIC) Sections 5150 et seq., 5585.50 through 5585.59 and 5751.7 are under DHCS.

The child's parent/legal guardian may file a complaint with DHCS indicating that the child was on a WIC 5585.50/WIC 5250 and was denied admission by the facility or express a concern about the services. This is applicable for adult consumers as well.
